The use of a Dermatoscope has transformed the assessment of skin lesions in recent years. These handheld devices, which provide illumination and magnification are already used by many GPs and nurses in Primary Care and have been proven to improve diagnostic accuracy and reduce unnecessary surgical procedures.

This webinar is designed to provide an introduction to Dermoscopy for complete beginners. It will demystify the technique and aims to generate interest in future study. Basic principles and the fundamentals of lesion recognition will be covered, as well as examples how it can change the management. Further resources and educational material will be highlighted.
