Overview

Headache is a common presentation in primary care, accounting for 4.4% of consultations. The lifetime prevalence of headache in the UK is over 90%. The majority of patients are managed by GPs: only 2–3% are referred to neurology services. However, primary care research highlights that migraine is underdiagnosed, with tension-type headache and sinus headache being over diagnosed.

In this interactive session, we will look at assessing headache in primary care, with a specific focus on migraine, its epidemiology, presentation, and management, with tips on when to refer to secondary care.
